## **2007 HYDRANT FLUSHING APRIL 16, 2007 through APRIL 30, 2007**

From Monday, April 16, 2007 through Monday, April 30, 2007, the City of Aurora Water Department will be flushing the waterlines throughout the system.

The purpose of this flushing is to improve carrying capacity and water quality, which will remove settled substances, and discolored or stale water.

Flushing will take place between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Customers may experience intermittent pressure fluctuations and a temporary condition of discolored water. If discoloration occurs, customers should **NOT** allow their water to run. This will not clear discoloration. The iron in the water main needs time to settle. Water clarity will return. Do **NOT** wash whites if water is discolored. Discolored water should dissipate within 1 or 2 days, but is safe for bathing, drinking and food preparation.

It is our suggestion that you complete all laundry prior to flushing in your area. Flushing in each area will last for approximately four (4) hours. Customers are asked to be patient during these periods. We appreciate your cooperation.
