- Parks are open! Please follow these guidelines in all public areas:
 - Minimum 6' social distancing
 - Masks are required for ages 2 and older when not with family group & unable to maintain social distancing
 - Public Restrooms are open—please keep them clean. Wash hands with soap for 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer regularly.
 - Do not congregate—No groups of more than 10
 - Stay home if you are not feeling well
 - Use trash cans or take your trash with you when possible
